Domaine Vincent Bouzereau Cremant de Bourgogne 20 | 105

Ever tried French bubbles that aren't champagne? Meet Crémant, the sparkling wine gem made outside the Champagne region. With its delicate sparkle and pure, light bouquet, this is a bubbly adventure waiting to be discovered.

Domaine Jean Fery Bourgogne Aligoté 30 | 140

Aligoté is Burgundy's 'other' white grape, often overshadowed by Chardonnay. This organically certified wine comes off citrusy and light, perfect as an aperitif or to complement any of our dishes.

Domaine Taupenot-Merme Saint-Romain Blanc 35 | 165

The estate's legacy in Saint Romain is deeply entrenched in history. Home to the Taupenot family for generations, these ancient vines that have been nurtured through the ages. Thanks to the higher elevation and limestone-rich soil, this blanc bursts with a lively, bright punch, floral aromas, and a luxurious, rounded finish. A taste of history in every sip.

François Labet Bourgogne V.V. 33 | 155

Crafted from only the finest grapes, this wine boasts a full-bodied richness with whispers of dark fruits and a velvety smooth finish. A sophisticated gem to elevate your palate.

Domaine Elodie Roy Santenay 1er Cru Les Gravieres 42 | 200

Close to the stony, clay soils of Chassagne Montrachet, this vineyard isn't just about whites –it's Elodie's playground for crafting top-tier reds from vines planted way back in '52. Picture a wine that's laidback yet lively, bursting with generous summer berries. Its supple tannins and finesse on the finish? Pure delight, making each sip a rewarding journey.

Mark Haisma Gevrey-Chambertin 55 | 265

Imagine a nose ripe with earthy red and dark berries, leaning towards the vibrant side of the spectrum. The flavours dance with verve, offering a round, delightfully complex experience that's both fresh and pretty. Thanks to Mark Haisma, a pioneer among Burgundy's new micro-négociants crafting his own wines, this creation delivers a finish that's intense, persistent, and perfectly balanced.
