Take a flight to South Africa and delve into these familiar, yet distinct wines showcasing the rich diversity from the new world. Pick 3 for a wine flight or have them by the glass.

### **Kleine Zalze MCC Brut**

**16 | 128**

**Chardonnay, Pinot noir | Stellenbosch**

MCC, or Méthode Cap Classique, represents the pinnacle of South African sparkling wines, crafted using the traditional method that also gives rise to champagne. These wines are celebrated for their fine, effervescent bubbles and vibrant, citrusy profile.

### **Remhoogte Free to Be Weisser Riesling**

**16 | 130**

**Weisser Riesling | Stellenbosch**

Naturally fermented using wild yeasts, it boasts a fresh and zesty profile, enriched with sweet fruit flavours and a hint of limey acidity, all complemented by a subtle waxy texture.

### **Newton Johnson Family Vineyards Chardonnay**

**21 | 165**

**Chardonnay | Hermanus**

Discover the vibrant complexity of this Chardonnay, featuring lucid notes of ripe citrus and white peaches. The lush fruitiness is counterbalanced by crisp mineral tones and a distinctive gunflint edge.

### **Savage Follow the Line**

**Cinsault | Swartland**

Experience the charm of South Africa's Pinot Noir, a delightful wine bursting with fresh flavours of strawberries and cherries, complemented by the delicate scent of rose petals.

### **A.A. Badenhorst Family Red**

**24 | 193**

**Shiraz, Cinsault, Grenache, Tinta Barocco, Touriga Nacional | Swartland**

Indulge in the complexity of this red, starting with a nose rich in aromas of black cherry, white pepper, dried flowers, and liquorice. On the palate, it's laden with layers of fruit, with a delicious berry finish and a hint of lavender.

### **Groot Constantia Grand Constance**

**35 | 280**

**Muscat de Frontignan | Constantia**

Famously enjoyed by Napoleon until his death in 1821 on Saint Helena, this legendary sweet wine brims with notes of honey, apricot, pineapple, and Turkish delights.
